Last chance to see Derfner exhibit

THROUGH SUNDAY, MAY 22, Derfner Judaica Museum, located at the Hebrew Home at Riverdale, 5901 Palisade Ave., is hosting an exhibition entitled Micaela Amato: Exile Traces. The exhibition includes selections from three series: Ancestral Traces; Exiles and Nomads; and Ants and Luminous Insects. Many of Ms. Amato's works utilize handwritten text, montage, collage and multiple viewpoints to suggest the complexity of her background as a daughter in a Ladino-speaking Sephardi immigrant family, who originated in Spain, lived in Rhodes and Turkey and, ultimately, immigrated to the Bronx.
