The Hebrew Home at Riverdale, 5901 Palisade Ave., presents "Water Works: Paintings of the Hudson River and Other Views," an exhibition by Bronx artist Robert Seyffert, now on display through Sunday, Oct. 11. This special installation, which is being held in conjunction with New York State's Hudson River Quadricentennial celebration, highlights a collection of images that are inspired by the Atlantic and Pacific Oceans, and the many watercourses in between, including the vast and majestic Hudson. The paintings on view reflect Mr. Seyffert's ongoing interest in the shorelines and rivers of New York, Maine, Nova Scotia and California, as well as the fragile ecosystems they contain.
