### Exhibit displays photos of Israel

The Hebrew Home for the Aged at Riverdale, at 5901 Palisade Ave., will hold the exhibit "Karen Gillerman-Harel: Mind, Body and Land," from Sunday, May 20 through Monday, July 9, from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.
